

## Physician NDC Code Provider Update - June 2011

Effective with claims process after April 1, 2011, the Kentucky Medicaid Program added the coverage of J3590 with NDC 50242006001 or 50242006101 for a flat rate of \$61.87.

If the NDC matches to the procedure code, check to make sure the following diagnosis codes are on the claim form:

362.02	362.07	362.16	362.35	362.36
362.52	362.53	362.83	364.42	365.63

Limit the quantity to one (1) to J3590 with either of the two NDC's above.

To use this agent, the ophthalmologist must have extensive experience in the treatment of wet AMD and use the latest guidelines on patient care for administration of bevacizumab.

The following documentation must be kept in patient chart:

- screening for medical indications which would contraindicate the use of bevacizumab and
- patient consent form for "off-label" use of bevacizumab and entry in medical record if patient understands the risks and benefits of the use of this drug in an off label setting.
