92 year old, comfort cares. Active family involvement.
End stage dementia making speech difficult to understand.
Becomes frustrated when attempting to converse and can not express self.
Has attempted to hit at staff during cares, but easily redirects with calm approach
Enjoys looking at family pictures and mechanic magazines
Ambulate independently throughout the day on memory care unit.
Has had no falls in past year. No history of fractures.
No evidence of discomfort
Spits out medications when crushed, so staff attempt to float meds in applesauce
Resident pockets medications, staff intervention is to check back in 5 minutes to ensure he has swallowed medications.
Had episode of pneumonia 8 months prior with stage 1 alteration on R heel. Area resolved with no further skin alterations.
Weights stable. Enjoys eating favorite foods when family supplies.
Family requests no lab work due to resistive behaviors.
