Public Hearing Set for the Kentucky State Plan on Aging

Pursuant to the federal regulations issued in 2024, the Department for Aging and Independent Living (DAIL) must submit an amendment to the previously approved 2025-2028 Kentucky State Plan on Aging. DAIL will host a public hearing to review the proposed changes to the previously approved State Plan on Aging prior to submission to the Administration for Community Living. The plan is required by the Older Americans Act and will be effective October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2028. The public hearing will be held virtually at 1 p.m., EST on Tuesday June 3, 2025, on Zoom and is accessible through the following link:

DAIL is primarily responsible for the coordination of all State activities related to the purposes of the Act, i.e., the development of comprehensive and coordinated service systems and nutrition services, and to serve as the effective and visible advocate for older Kentuckians.
