## What are Recovery Community Centers (RCCs)?



RCCs are non-profit centers offering support services such as mutual aid, peer support, employment and housing resources, and fellowship with others from the Recovery Community.



RCCs are not residences or treatment centers, but serve as local hubs of community-based support.



RCCs are operated by peers with lived experience


