- 1. 907 KAR 3:190. Reimbursement for treatment related to clinical trials.
- A. This administrative regulation was filed on February 8, 2023.
- B. **Summary of Administrative Regulation:** This administrative regulation establishes the coverage and reimbursement requirements for routine patient costs as required by the federal Clinical Treatment Act. In addition, this administrative regulation will allow Medicaid beneficiaries to more fully participate in clinical trials.
