Kentucky Medicaid Program Coverage Update: Guide to utilizing Self-Measured Blood Pressure (SMBP) benefits

General steps for ordering devices and providing clinical support to eligible patients on Medicaid:

All Medicaid Providers

Determine if patient is eligible for device

- Verify eligibility for Kentucky Medicaid beneficiaries by calling the automated voice response system at (800) 807-1301 or visit the web-based KYHealth-Net System.
- Prior authorization is not required for blood pressure devices

Billing

- Non-inpatient billing:
 - If patient is covered under the fee for service Medicaid program, utilize the Gainwell platform to submit claim
 - o If patient is covered under MCO, refer to relevant procedure for submitting claims:
 - Aetna Better Health of KY (855) 300-5528
 - Humana (800) 444-9137
 - Passport by Molina (800) 578-0775
 - Wellcare of KY (877) 389-9457
 - <u>United (877) 838-5085</u>
- Inpatient Billing
 - o Hospital will include device and education in billing.

Clinicians enrolled in KY Medicaid

Step 1: See KY Medicaid member

• Clinician determines if it is medically necessary for a KY Medicaid member to receive selfmeasured blood pressure treatment.

Step 2: Clinician writes order for monitor

- Clinician writes an order for the monitor:
 - If member is admitted inpatient, hospital provides monitor and education on usage;
 or
 - o Order is sent to a Medical Supplies, Equipment, and Appliances (MSEA) provider.

Step 3: Provide patient with ongoing SMBP support

Follow SMBP protocol (see resources for more information).

- Share plan with patient on how often to take readings, record them, and communicate back.
- Update treatment plan as necessary based on SMBP readings.
- Clinician monitors patient reported readings and documents/charts results.

Step 4: Billing

- Clinicians may bill for:
 - Visit:
 - Education; and
 - Monitoring.
- Submit claims for SMBP clinical services using CPT® codes
 - o Medicaid providers may be reimbursed for SMBP services using:
 - 99473, for patient device education and training; and
 - 99474, for data collection and interpretation.

Medical Supplies, Equipment, and Appliances Providers enrolled in KY Medicaid

Step 1: Receive Order from Clinician

Step 2: Process order to ensure monitor is in stock or order monitor.

Step 3: Contact member to:

- Set appointment for monitor pick-up and education; or
- Mail monitor and schedule telehealth education appointment.

Step 4: Deliver monitor

• Give monitor to member in person or mail monitor to member

Step 5: Educate member on monitor use

Ensure member knows how to use and read monitor.

Step 6: Billing

- MSEA Providers may bill for the device using:
 - A4660, for Sphygmomanometer Blood Pressure apparatus with scope and stethoscope.
 - o A4663, Blood Pressure Cuff or Dialysis Blood Pressure Cuff; and
 - o A4670, Automatic Blood Pressure Monitor.
