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Casgevy Clinical Authorization Criteria

- Confirmatory genetic testing; **AND**
- Failure or intolerance to hydroxyurea (defined as being unable to take hydroxyurea per health care professional judgment) at any point in the past.; **AND**
- Age twelve (12) years and older at the expected time of gene therapy administration; **AND**
- Clinically stable and fit for transplantation; **AND**
- Prescribed by or in consultation with a board-certified hematologist with Sickle Cell Disease expertise; **AND**
- Experienced recurrent VOCs (defined as more than or equal to two (2) documented VOCs per year in the previous twenty-four (24) months, based on provider attestation); **AND**
- Casgevy will not be administered during pregnancy due to the risk of myeloablative conditioning.; **AND**
- Patients will not have a history of prior allogeneic or autologous Hematopoietic Stem Cell transplant.; **AND**
- Casgevy will not be used in patients with active HIV-1, HIV-2, HBV, or HCV.; **AND**
- Casgevy will not be administered during pregnancy and/or breastfeeding will be discontinued due to the potential risks associated with myeloablative conditioning.; **AND**
- Authorization will be approved for 1 year if the patient meets all of the criteria above.
