To receive the correct coverage and access to benefits, you must notify the Department of Community Based Services (DCBS) of your pregnancy. To report your pregnancy, contact DCBS at 1-855-306-8959.

Resources and services available to Medicaid members include:

- Free access to birth control and contraceptive options
- Regular check-ups during pregnancy (Prenatal visits)
- Imaging to monitor pregnancy (ultrasounds)

- Fully covered vaginal and c-section births
- Midwife-assisted births
- Breast feeding support, including one free breast pump per pregnancy
- Dental and Vision benefits
- Vaccines during pregnancy
- Programs to support weight management
- Medical Nutrition therapy
- Support with managing diabetes and gestational diabetes
- Screening, testing, and treatment for Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)
- Treatment for Substance Use Disorder (SUD)
- Medication to quit smoking
- HIV/AIDS care and medication
- Follow-up care after delivery (Postpartum visits)
- 12 Month Coverage- eligible for Medicaid benefits after birth.
