

Application Statuses

An Application or Maintenance item may have several different statuses depending on where it is in the life cycle.

The following table defines each status and notes if information in the corresponding status is viewable and/or editable to users.

Status	Definition
In Progress	A Provider or Credentialing Agent (CA) is working on the application. It has not been submitted to DMS for review. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information can be updated and edited while the application is In Progress.
Submitted	A Provider or Credentialing Agent has completed the application and submitted it to DMS, but DMS has not begun reviewing the application. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Once the application is submitted, information cannot be updated or edited.
DMS Review in Progress	DMS staff is reviewing the application. There are three possible outcomes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Approved - Denied - Return to Provider (DMS has determined additional information is required before making a decision.) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information cannot be updated or edited when the application is in DMS Review in Progress.
Approved	DMS has completed its review and assigned the Provider a Medicaid ID. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information cannot be updated or edited once the application has been Approved.
Update Accepted	DMS has approved the changes made during a Maintenance or Revalidation.
Denied	DMS has rejected the New Enrollment application. The application cannot be updated, and the user will have to start over. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information cannot be updated or edited once the application is Denied.

Status	Definition
Update Not Accepted	DMS rejected the changes made during a Maintenance or Revalidation.
Withdrawn	The application was removed from the New Enrollment or Maintenance process. The application cannot be restarted. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Information cannot be updated or edited once the application has been Withdrawn.
Abandoned	The application was not submitted to DMS within 120 days of starting the application or from the date it was returned for corrections.
