XXIII. Targeted Case Management and Diagnostic, Preventive and Rehabilitative Early Intervention Services for children eligible for the Early Intervention program provided through a Title V agreement.

This payment system is for all providers, including those providing services under the Title V agreement described in Supplement 1 to Attachment 4.16-A, Item #10.

All costs shall be determined based on the methodology outlined in 0MB Circular A-87. Payments for case management, diagnostic, rehabilitative, and preventive early intervention services shall be made in accordance with a fee schedule established by the Title V agency. Interim payments shall be based on the direct cost of providing the service. Payments for overhead and administrative costs associated with providing the service shall be determined with a settlement to cost at the end of the fiscal year. Providers will submit cost reports no later than 180 days after the end of the state fiscal year.
