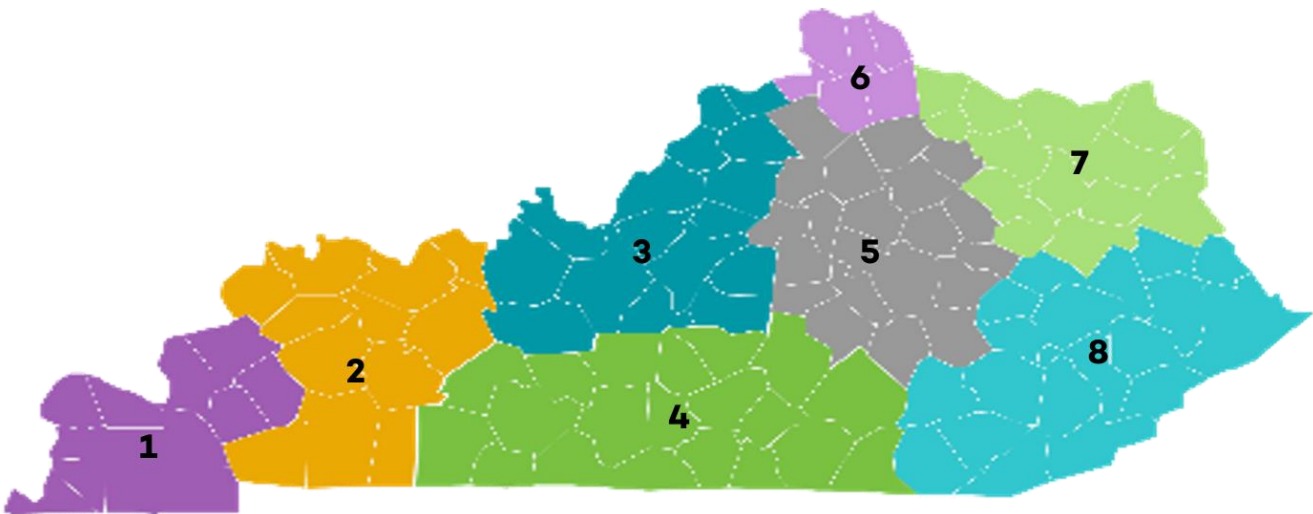

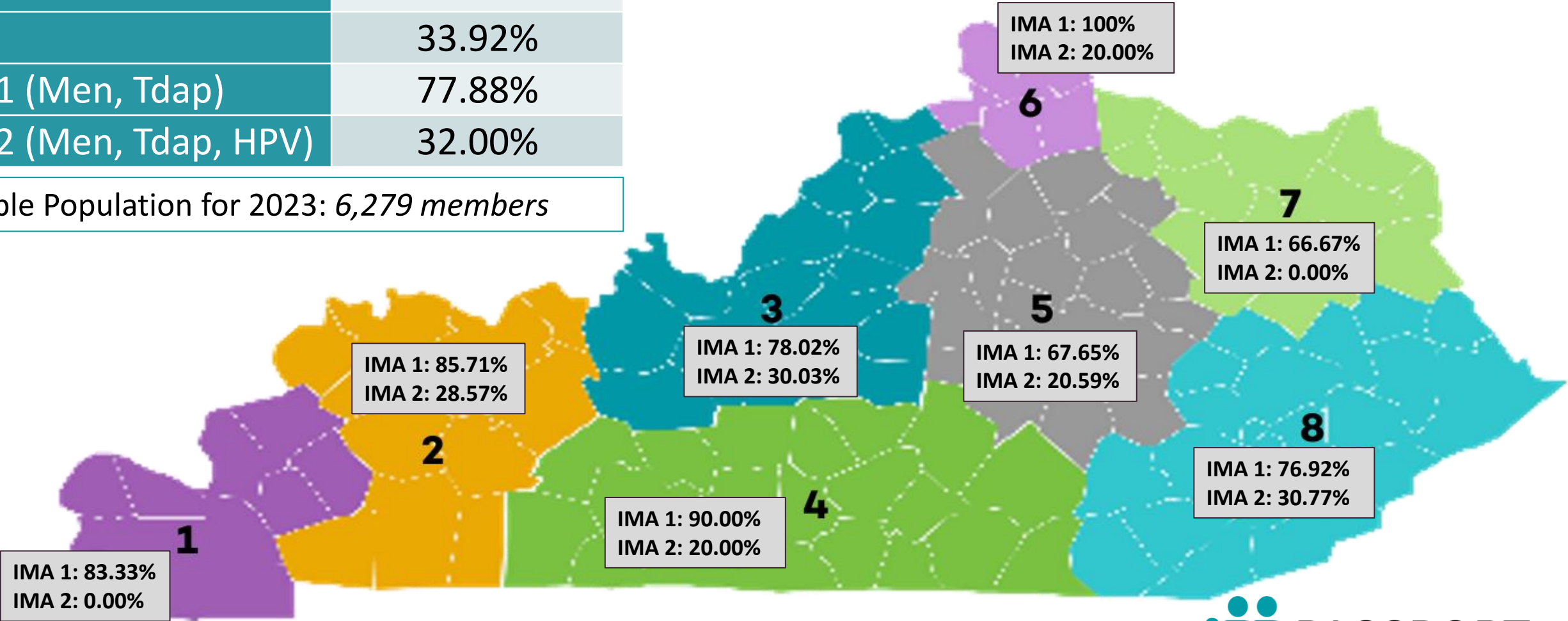

To qualify for a VAB, members must have Passport by Molina Healthcare Medicaid. If reward is offered by both Molina Medicaid and Medicare, it can be claimed once and will be provided by the member’s primary insurance. Rewards must be claimed within 90 calendar days of receiving the qualifying service and members must be currently enrolled with Passport Medicaid at the time of claiming the reward.

Verification of services is required in the form of claims submission or provider attestation form. Attestation form can be found at www.passporthealthplan.com/benefits or members can call Passport Member Services at (800) 578-0603 and request a form be mailed to them.
