## ARE YOU UP-TO-DATE ON THE COVID-19 VACCINE?

A person is Up-to-Date when they have received all recommended COVID-19 vaccine doses, including any booster dose(s) when eligible.

## Pediatric (5-17)

- 2 dose primary series less than 5 months ago; or
- Booster 5 months after completion of the primary series.



#### For Pfizer or Moderna,

- 2 dose primary series less than5 months ago; or
- Booster 5 months after completion of the primary series.

#### Adult (18+)



#### For **J&J**,

- 1 dose primary series less than 2 months ago; or
- Booster 2 months after completion of the primary series.

#### **2nd Booster**

Everyone ages 50 years and older who received any COVID-19 booster dose should receive a second booster dose using an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine 4 months after most recent dose.

### <u>Immunocompromised</u>

# (Ages 5-11) Pfizer

- 2 dose series less than 28 days ago; or
- 1 additional dose (3rd dose to complete primary series).
- Booster (4th dose)
   3 months after
   completion of
   primary 3 dose
   series.

#### (Ages 12+) Pfizer

- 2 dose series less than 28 days ago; or
- 1 additional dose (3rd dose to complete primary series) less than 3 months ago; or
- Booster (4th dose) 3
  months after completion
  of primary 3 dose series.
- Booster (5th dose) 4
  months after completion
  of most recent dose.

#### (Ages 18+) Moderna

- 2 dose series less than 28 days ago; or
- 1 additional dose (3rd dose to complete primary series) less than 3 months ago; or
- Booster (4th dose) 3
  months after completion
  of primary 3 dose series.
- Booster (5th dose) 4
  months after completion
  of most recent dose.

#### (Ages 18+) <u>J&J</u>

- 1 dose primary series less than 28 days ago;
- 1 additional dose (2nd dose, Moderna or Pfizer) less than 2 months ago;
- Booster dose (3rd dose) 2 months after second dose preferably with Moderna or Pfizer (3 total doses).
- OPTIONAL: Booster (4th dose) 4 months after completion of most recent dose.
