WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

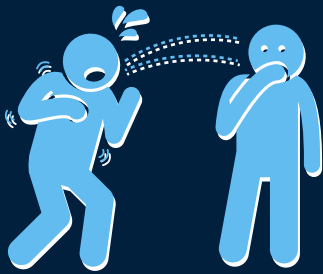
Mumps is a highly contagious viral disease of the salivary glands best known for causing painful puffy cheeks.

MORE THAN SWOLLEN GLANDS. MUMPS CAN BE DANGEROUS.

Can lead to deafness, infections of the brain (meningitis) and swelling of the brain (encephalitis).

SYMPTOMS:

- Fever
- Swollen glands
- Headaches
- Muscle aches
- Tiredness
- Loss of appetite



Spread via coughing, sneezing, and contact with infected saliva.
