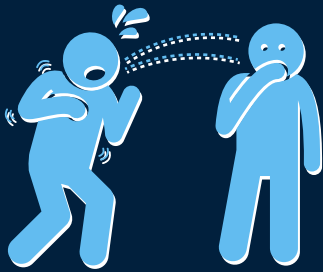
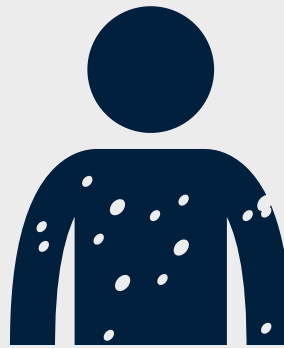
## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Varicella zoster virus (chickenpox) is an acute and highly contagious viral disease.

Virus may remain dormant in the nervous system and can lead to shingles outbreaks later in life.

## SYMPTOMS:

- Itchy rash/Blisters
- Burning pain
- High fever
- Tiredness
- Loss of appetite
- Headache
