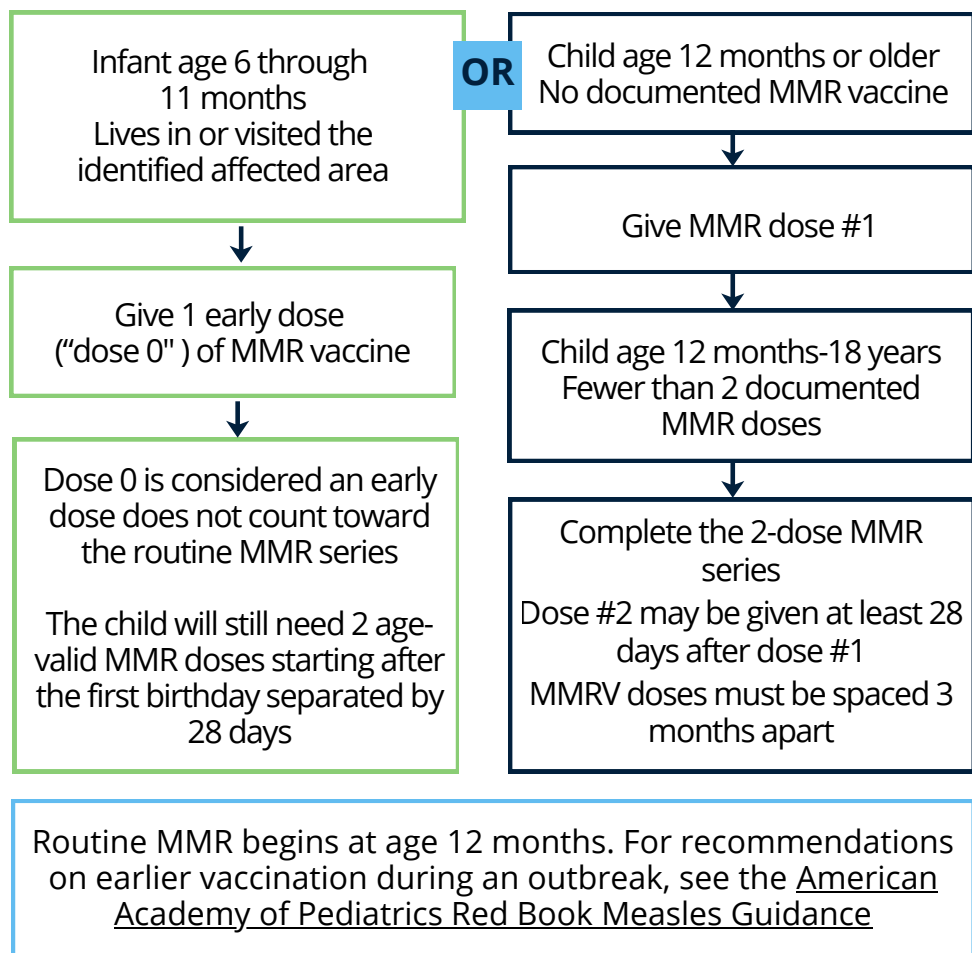


MMR Vaccination Guidance for Children 6 Months Through 18 Years During Kentucky Measles Outbreak

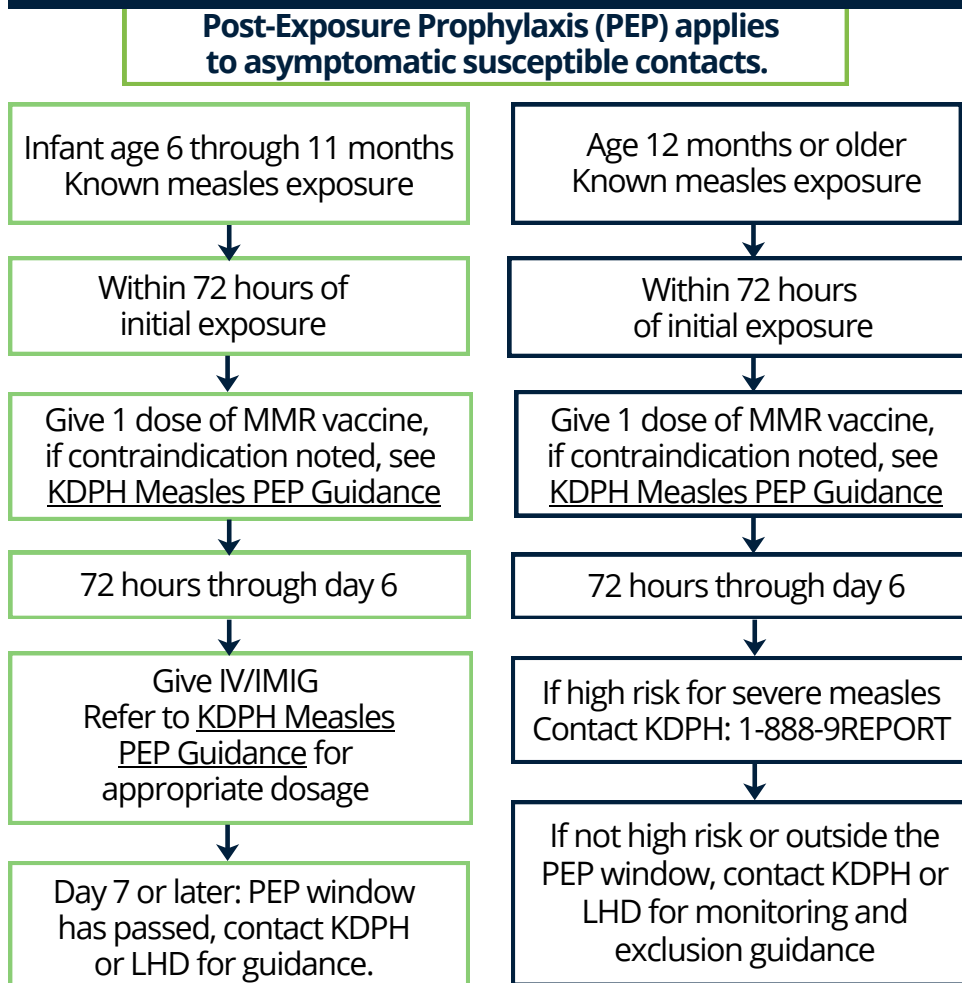
Due to the ongoing measles outbreak in Kentucky, this guidance is intended to help providers determine when MMR vaccination may be recommended for children at increased risk of measles exposure. Increased risk includes living in, visiting, or planning to visit an identified affected area; having regular contact with an affected community; or traveling internationally. These recommendations apply to children without contraindications to MMR vaccination.
