- Pregnant women who get vaccinated pass antibodies to their babies, protecting babies in the first few months of life before they can get their own vaccines
- Women with influenza are TWICE as likely to be hospitalized if they are pregnant.
- RSV is the LEADING CAUSE of infant hospitalization in the U.S.
- 69% of whooping cough DEATHS occur in babies less than 2 months.
