WHEREAS, Radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States; testing for radon is simple and inexpensive, and identified radon problems can be fixed; and

WHEREAS, The Cabinet for Health and Family Services Department for Public Health's Radon Program, participating local health departments, and the United States Environmental Protection Agency are supporting efforts to encourage Kentuckians to test their homes for radon, to have elevated levels of radon reduced, and to reveal the benefits of building radon resistant homes;
