The Kentucky Women's Cancer Screening Program (KWCSP) is the state's safety net program that provides **AT NO COST TO YOU** mammograms and pap test screenings to women who qualify.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE



Woman age 21 and older



Household income at or below 250% of the federal poverty level



Uninsured - no other payor source

WHERE ARE KWCSP SERVICES OFFERED

The KWCSP partners with several locations to offer services to those who are eligible. These participating locations include:



Local health departments



Federally qualified health centers



Medical centers and hospitals

KWCSP & BCCTP

If you received services through the Kentucky Women's Cancer Screening Program and you are diagnosed with cancer, you may be eligible for short-term Medicaid through the Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program (BCCTP). The BCCTP helps cover the cost of cancer treatment, doctor visits, emergency room visits, dental and vision care.
