
KWCSP Updates

Revised WH-58 Form is effective January 1, 2023.

We have a new KWCSP approved CPT code Version 13.0. The new rate list will be effective January 1, 2023. Based on the new rate list, LHDs are going to get more reimbursements from the program.

KWCSP Reimbursements

- 1. All LHDs will see an increased reimbursements in their July payments from the program for FY 2023.
- 2. If a patient had services in FY 2023. Please get your bills from providers as soon as possible so that we can reimburse you from the 2023 grant amount.
- 3. LHDs on **ezEMRx** System: Please check your total reimbursements amount. If you have paid more to your providers for KWCSP for clinical services but those payments don't match with our payments to you. Please reach out to me ASAP.



1. Q: Do we complete WH-58 form for Family Planning Program patients?

A: "Yes only if a FP patient has Pap and/HPV test/ follow-up diagnostic services. If a patient had just CBE and it is normal, then you don't have to complete the form.

2. Q: Do we complete WH-58 form if a patient only had a pelvic exam but no other services including CBE, Pap, HPV or a mammogram?

A: No, do not fill out WH-58 forms/cancer screen on such patients. CDC does not consider pelvic exam as a cervical cancer screening service.

- ♥ 3. Q: Can patients be screened who don't reside in Kentucky? Has this changed?
 - **A:** KWCSP will reimburse for services for any patient as long as they qualify, irrespective of their primary residence.
- **Q.** When entering the 'Prior PAP test date' on the WH-58/Cancer Screen, it does not take the full date.
 - **A:** Please use 01 for unknown month and day. Ex: 01/01/2022.

♥ 5. Q: What do we do when several providers appear under the site #/county dropdown on the WH-58 Cancer Screen (no longer relevant)?

A: If providers have retired or no longer participating, please contact Local Health Operations @ localhealth.helpdesk@ky.gov 502-564-6663, Option 1. They will delete them from the list.

© 6. Q: When do we use the option of Lost to Follow-up?

A: "Lost to Follow-up" option should be used for women when tracking efforts have been attempted, but have failed regardless of whether the reason is known (i.e. death, moved).

7. Q: What date do we use to report Lost to Follow-up?

A: You can use the date of last contact with the patient or certified letter date.

8. Q: When do we use the option of Work-up Refused?

A: "Work-up Refused" option should be used when a patient does not keep an appointment or refuses services.

A: You can use the date of last contact with the patient or certified letter date.
