
Your child needs to be scheduled for a special hearing assessment called an Auditory Brainstem Response (ABR) test and/or an Otoacoustic Emissions (OAE) test. These tests allow us to find out how your child hears without requiring them to respond to sounds. We use these hearing tests for babies and those who cannot respond to traditional testing.

How are these tests completed?

It is important that your baby be as quiet as possible during this assessment. The measurements we are taking are very sensitive to noise and movement, so it is best if your baby is asleep.

What happens the day of the test?

A parent or legal guardian must bring the child to this appointment. The test may take about 2 hours. The audiologist will share the results of the tests and any recommendations.
