## **HCBS Waiver Redesign Stakeholder Advisory Group**

The Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS) has asked for stakeholder input on how to improve the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waivers. CHFS has organized a Stakeholder Advisory Group comprised of representatives of **self-advocates**, **family members**, **consumer advocacy groups**, **provider associations**, and **state waiver staff** to discuss elements and goals of the redesign. This group will make recommendations to CHFS on the organization, administration, and elements to be included in Kentucky's HCBS waivers moving forward.

# Feedback from the Stakeholder Advisory Group

Over the past several months, Commissioner Anderson conducted multiple listening sessions with various stakeholders across the Commonwealth to collect feedback on what is working well and where we need to improve the current HCBS waivers. In addition to the feedback these groups provided, stakeholders attending the waiver redesign sessions on December 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016 also shared feedback, and identified potential challenges and success factors to improving Kentucky's HCBS waivers. The Stakeholder Advisory Group reviewed all feedback and developed a list of Critical Elements to guide the waiver redesign process.

Elements that stakeholders have identified as important components of a redesigned waiver.

Factors that need to be considered and overcome to achieve the goals of waiver redesign.

#### **Success Factors**


Factors that are necessary to successfully achieve the goals of waiver redesign.

## Goals of HCBS Waiver Redesign Determined by Stakeholder Advisory Group

Goal	Description
Access & Quality	Ensure that individuals receive and have access to the services that they need, that the
	services are of high-quality, and services are received in a timely manner.
Collaboration	Create an environment that fosters continuous feedback, learning, and improvement, which
	establishes trust amongst stakeholders, and encourages ambassadors for change.
Communication	Develop clear and consistent communications so that all stakeholders receive the same
	information in an understandable manner.
Consistency	Make waiver services more consistent (across waivers and across the state) with
	predictable and efficient processes (including enrollment).
Simplification	Streamline and simplify processes and documentation and reduce redundancies.
Sustainability	Design programs that will work for the long-term that are aligned/compliant with the HCBS
	Final Rules, and create financially sustainable program design and rates.
Flexibility	Develop a seamless system that serves individuals across their lifespan and gives them what
	they need, recognizing that medical and life events occur.

# **Next Steps**

Over the next few months, the Stakeholder Advisory Group will continue to develop recommendations for the future design of the HCBS waivers. The group will work through recommendations for operationalizing each critical element and review potential models for HCBS delivery in Kentucky. CHFS leadership will consider the recommendations of the Stakeholder Advisory Group in developing future plans for Kentucky's HCBS waivers.
