# 2018 Annual Administrative Claims Data Report – Inpatient Hospitalizations

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for your interest in the **2018 Annual Administrative Claims Data Report – Inpatient Hospitalizations**. This report covers the inpatient hospital discharges from licensed Kentucky hospitals for the calendar year January 1 through December 31, 2018. The inpatient hospitalization records data submitted by hospitals as required by 900 KAR 7:030 – Data Reporting by Health Care Providers, was used to produce the utilization information in this report.

Beginning with the 2018 Kentucky Annual Administrative Claims Data Reports, the Division of Analytics began using CCS diagnoses classifications for Section IV instead of individual diagnoses codes. The Clinical Classifications Software (CCS) for ICD-10-CM and PCS is based on the *International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision* (ICD-10), a uniform and standardized coding system. The ICD-10-CM/PCS's multitude of codes—over 69,800 diagnosis codes and 71,900 procedure codes—are collapsed into a smaller number of clinically meaningful categories that are sometimes more useful for presenting descriptive statistics than are individual ICD-10-CM/PCS codes. It can be a useful way to categorize conditions when exploring data and can serve as a tool for reporting statistical information on hospitalizations.

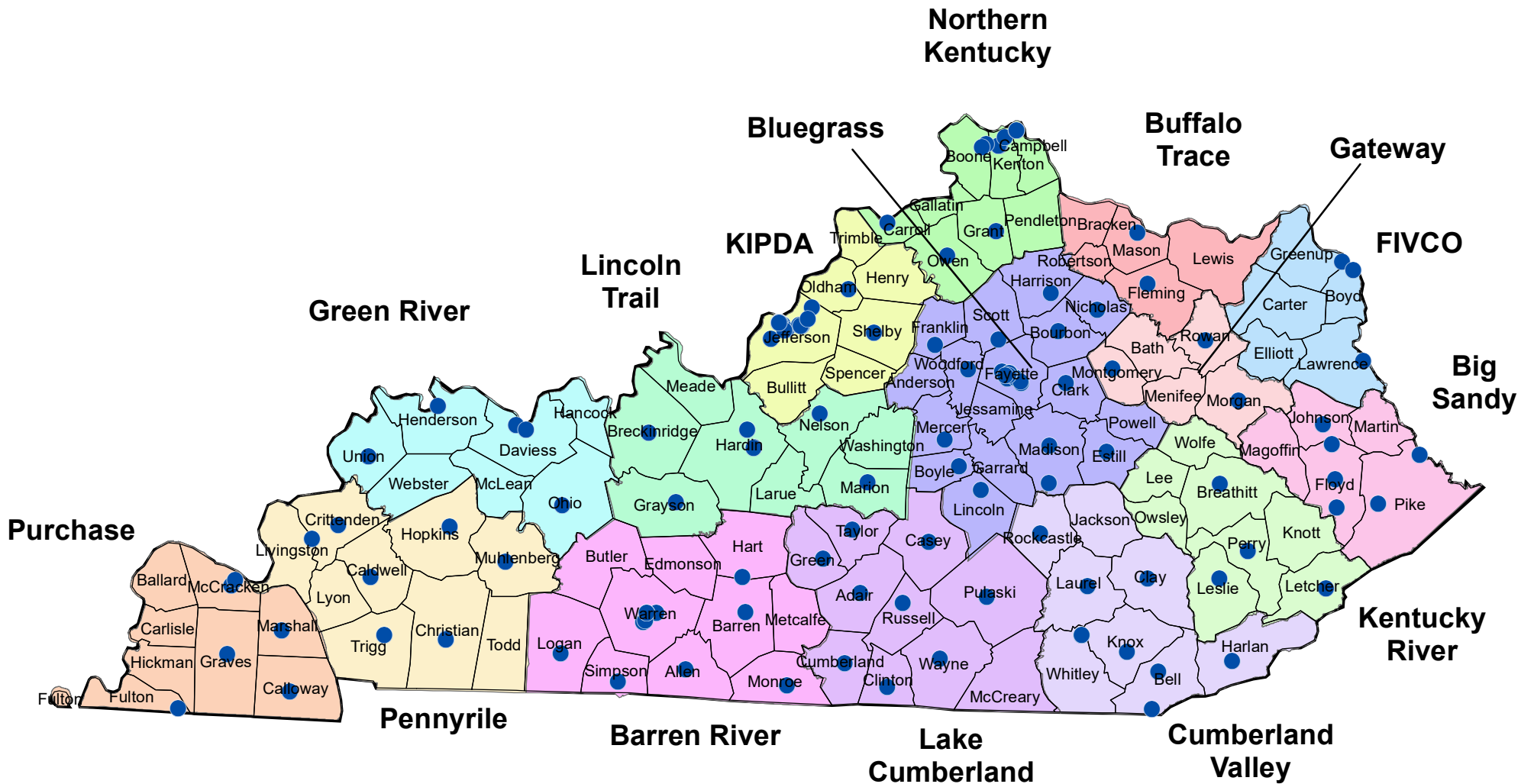

# 2018 Kentucky Hospitals with Inpatient Discharges



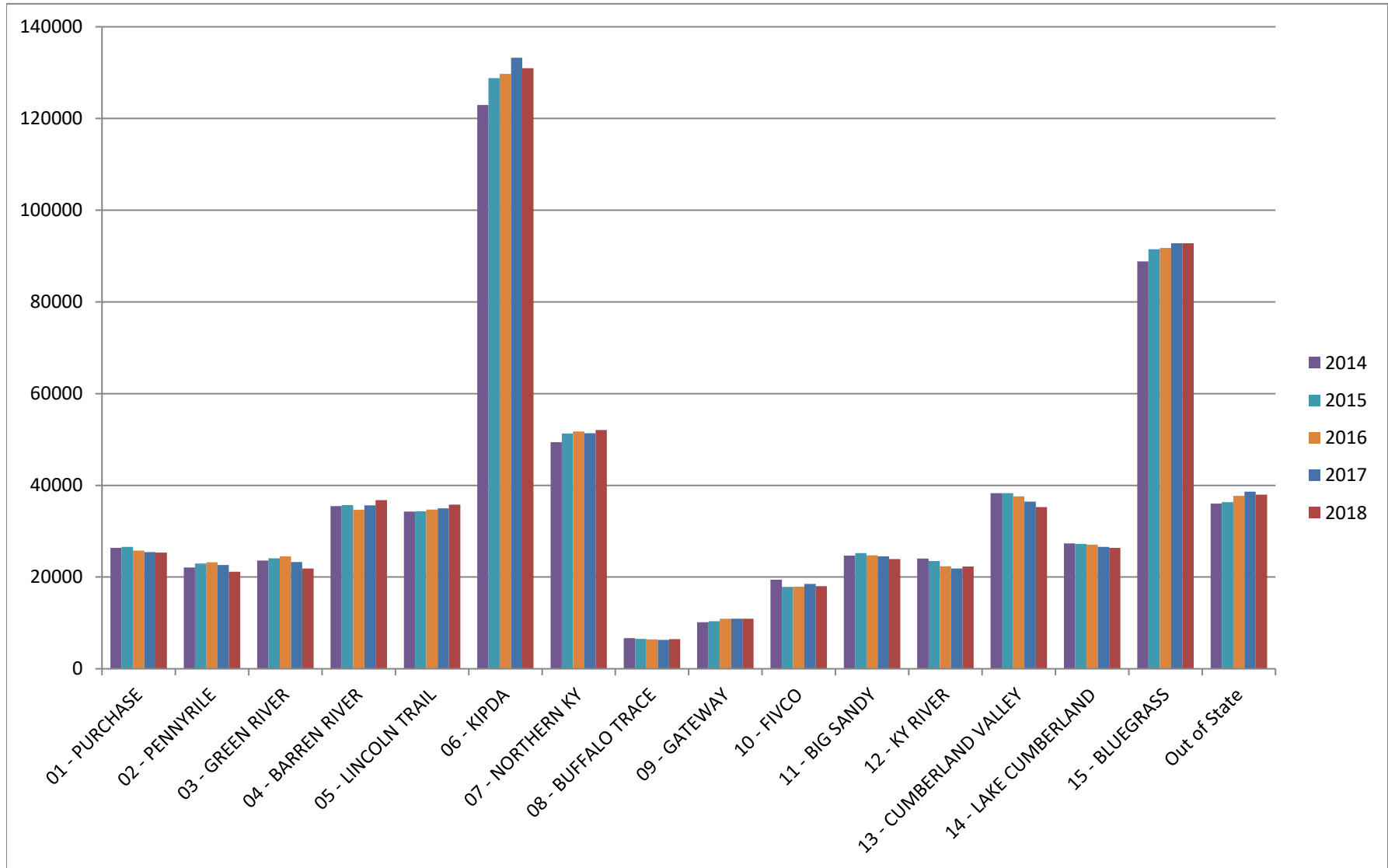

## Chart 1 - Inpatient Hospital Discharges by Year and Patient ADD

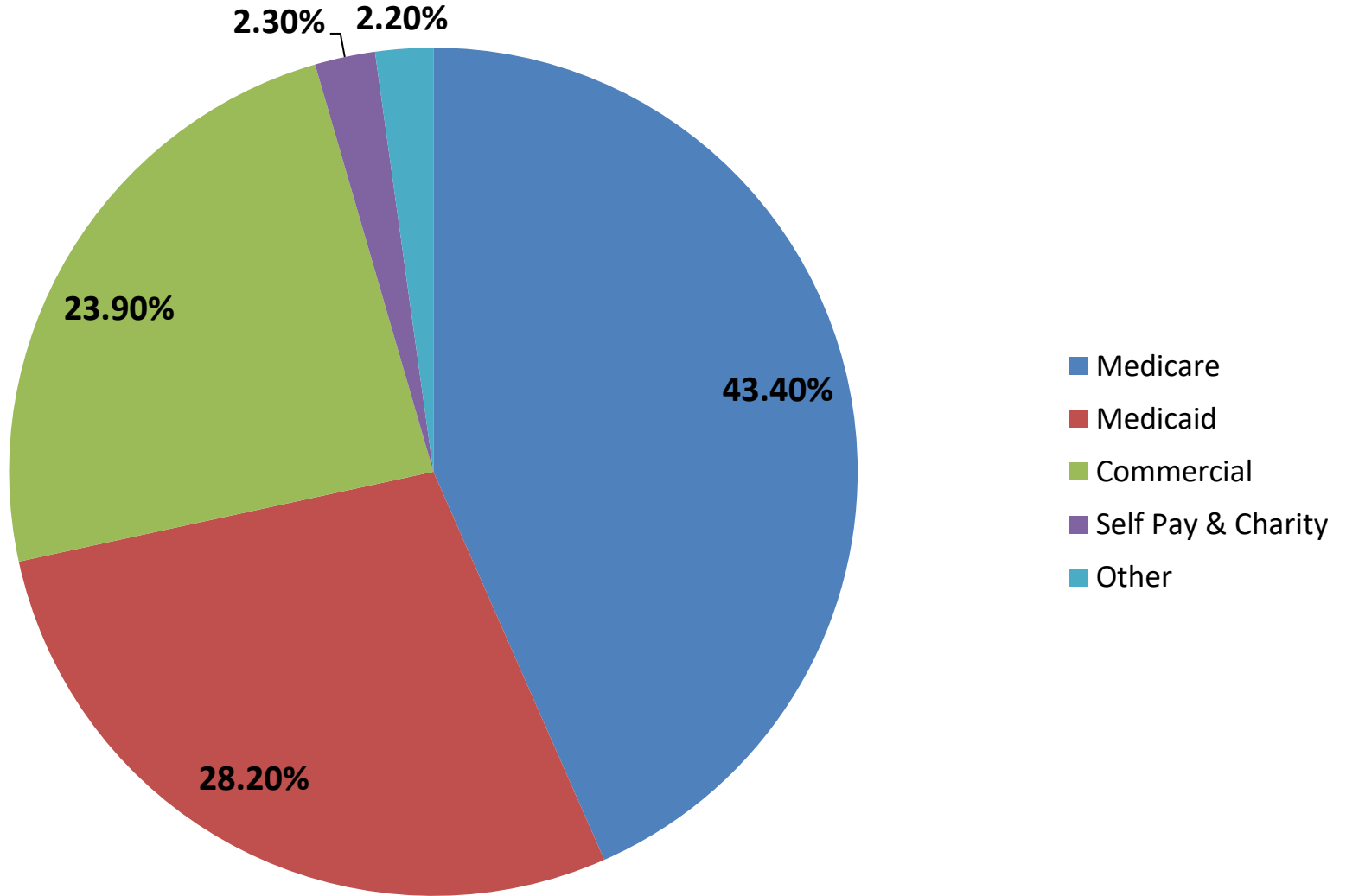

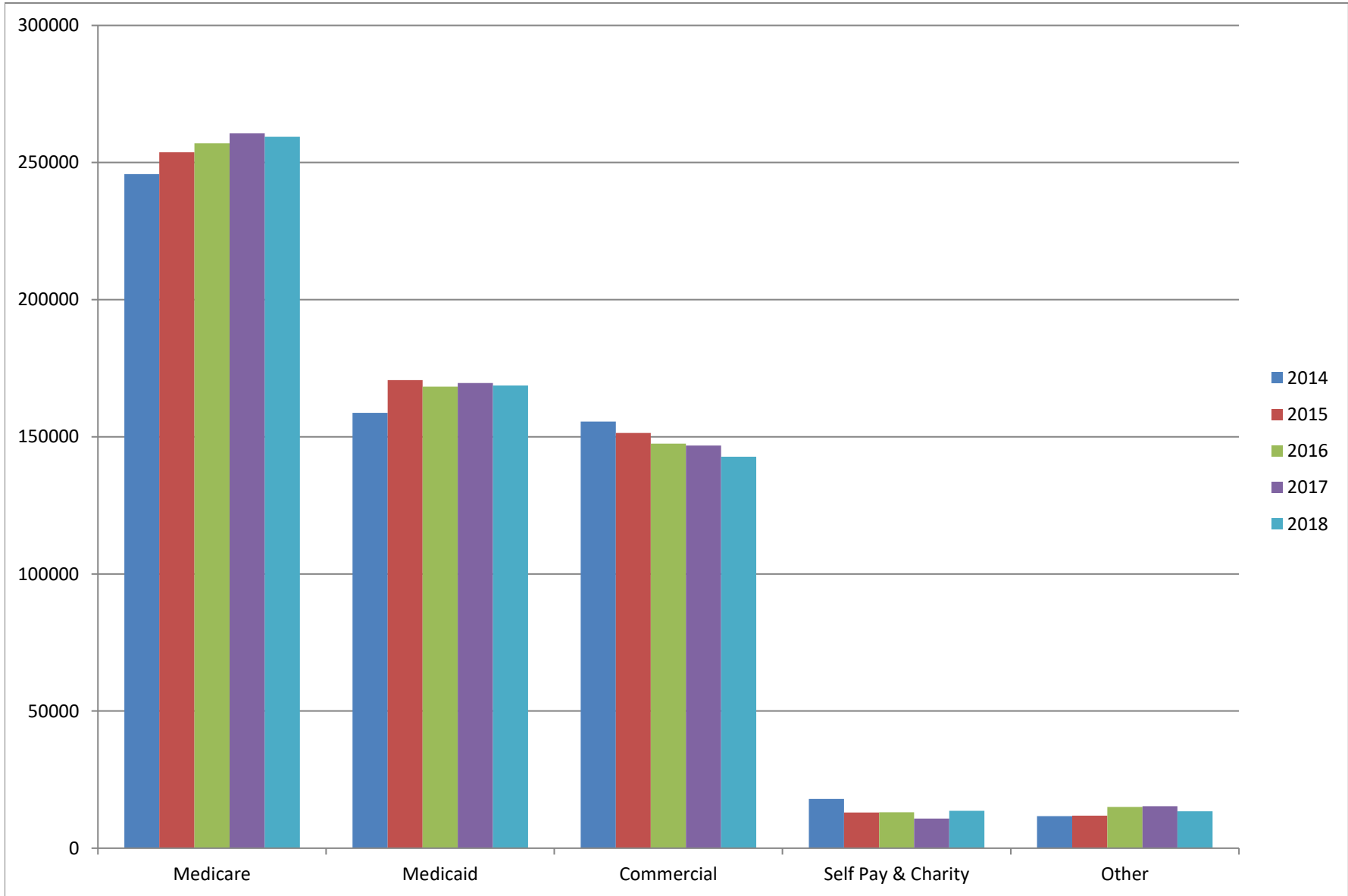

## Chart 3 - Inpatient Hospital Discharges by Year and Primary Payor

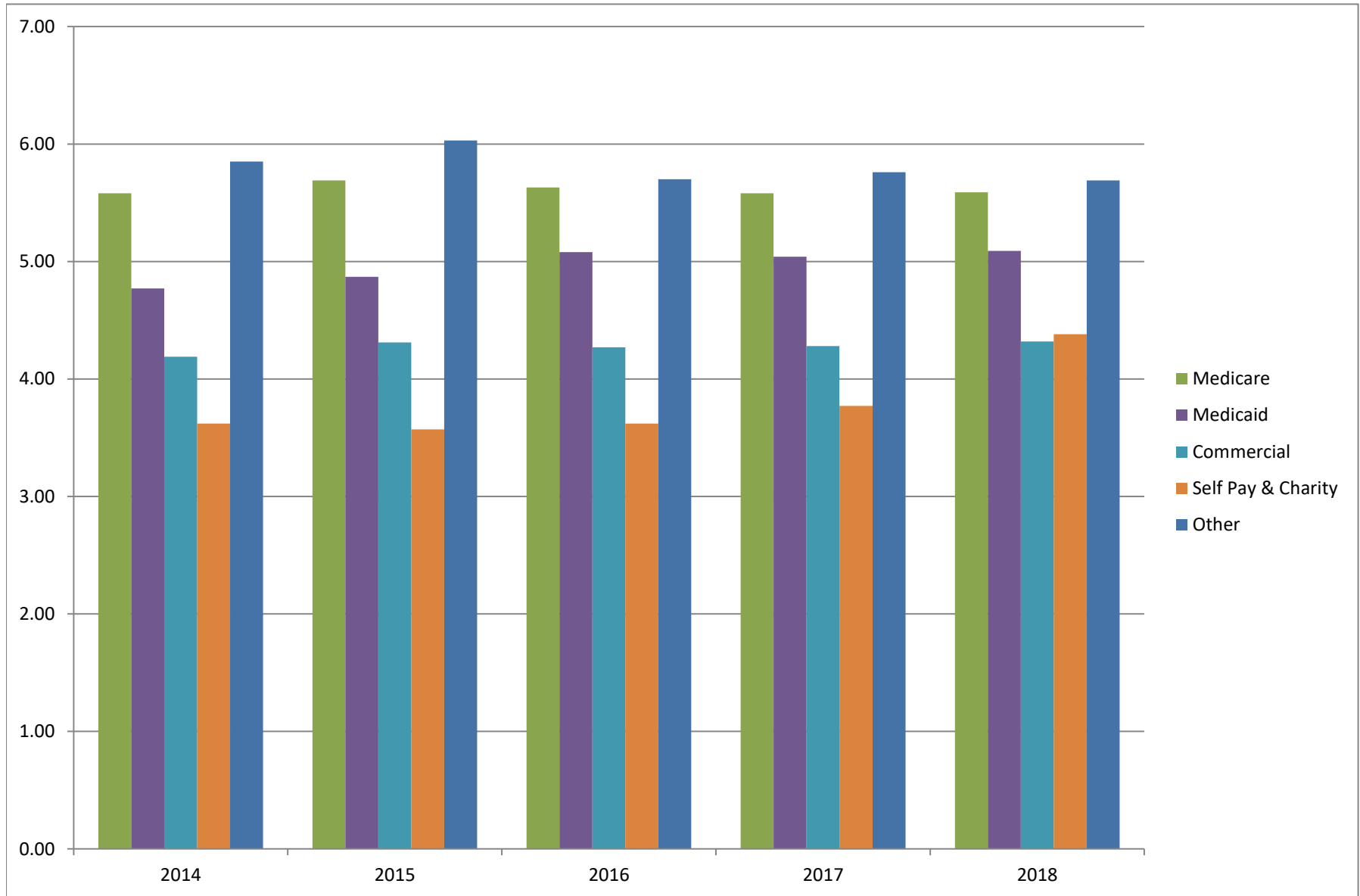
