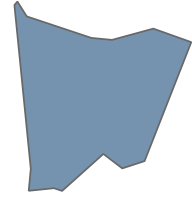

Across the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky 3,729 Serve Kentucky volunteers provided 792,753 hours of volunteer service (valued at \$1,032,063) in a little over a year between August 2020 and August 2021.

AmeriCorps members served 41,112 students and provided food support services to 56,877 students. Serve Kentucky also provided housing services to 2,073 individuals.

Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (KTAP)

Your county has received \$159,861 in KTAP issuance. This has been allocated to 48 households in the past fiscal year.

On average, SNAP serviced 1,078 people a month in Bracken County, stretching over 468 households. Total SNAP spending in your county in FY2022: \$2,831,655

Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

FRYSC in Bracken County received \$322,178 in funding, grants, community cash, and in-kind contributions with 3 full-time staff and 2 part-time staff.

As of 7/3/2022, there were 23 children in Out of Home Care, 23 of which received a per-diem, for a daily per-diem of \$2,016.

34% of children in the state's care had a goal of adoption. 0 child(ren) adopted (YTD)
65% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

Bracken County received \$111,204 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance supporting up to 34 providers a month.

The Division of Child Support Enforcement served on average 365 children a month, collecting \$634,535 in current and past due child support during FY 2022. They established 15 orders.

Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting (KASPER)

According to KASPER data, 2,412 unique patients residing in your county received a pharmaceutical controlled substance. Opioid analgesics accounted for 6,865 of the 17,721 total controlled prescriptions dispensed.

Residents of your county received these prescriptions from 1,135 prescribers and 168 dispenser DEA numbers.
