Across the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky 3,729 Serve Kentucky volunteers provided 792,753 hours of volunteer service (valued at \$1,032,063) in a little over a year between August 2020 and August 2021.

AmeriCorps members served 41,112 students and provided food support services to 56,877 students. Serve Kentucky also provided housing services to 2,073 individuals.

Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

FRYSC in Elliott County received \$290,309 in funding, grants, community cash, and in-kind contributions with 2 full-time staff and 2 part-time staff.

As of 7/3/2022, there were 9 children in Out of Home Care, 7 of which received a per-diem, for a daily per-diem of \$259.

22% of children in the state's care had a goal of adoption. 77% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

Elliott County received \$19,411 from the Child Care
Assistance Program issuance supporting up to 6 providers a
month.

The Division of Child Support Enforcement served on average 403 children a month, collecting \$479,429 in current and past due child support during FY 2022. They established 5 orders.

Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting (KASPER)

According to KASPER data, 1,525 unique patients residing in your county received a pharmaceutical controlled substance. Opioid analgesics accounted for 7,417 of the 14,138 total controlled prescriptions dispensed.

Residents of your county received these prescriptions from 709 prescribers and 119 dispenser DEA numbers.
