Across the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky 3,729 Serve Kentucky volunteers provided 792,753 hours of volunteer service (valued at \$1,032,063) in a little over a year between August 2020 and August 2021.

AmeriCorps members served 41,112 students and provided food support services to 56,877 students. Serve Kentucky also provided housing services to 2,073 individuals.

### Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (KTAP)

### Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

FRYSC in Garrard County received \$315,178 in funding, grants, community cash, and in-kind contributions with 4 full-time staff and 2 part-time staff.

As of 7/3/2022, there were 43 children in Out of Home Care, 40 of which received a per-diem, for a daily per-diem of \$3,179.

39% of children in the state's care had a goal of adoption.  
60% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

0 child(ren) adopted (YTD)

Garrard County received \$448,853 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance supporting up to 134 providers a month.

The Division of Child Support Enforcement served on average 859 children a month, collecting \$1,218,913 in current and past due child support during FY 2022. They established 19 orders.

### Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting (KASPER)

According to KASPER data, 5,223 unique patients residing in your county received a pharmaceutical controlled substance. Opioid analgesics accounted for 18,074 of the 40,736 total controlled prescriptions dispensed.
