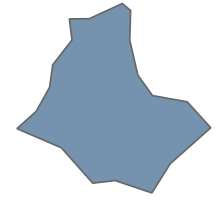

Serve Kentucky manages AmeriCorps programs across the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky. 688 AmeriCorps members served 750,569 hours and recruited 4,705 volunteers who provided 181,290 hours of volunteer service (valued at \$5,429,636). AmeriCorps members served 45,685 students and provided food support services to 2,609 students. Serve Kentucky also provided housing services to 1,730 individuals and collected 75,035 pounds of food for individuals facing food insecurity.

AmeriCorps has 3 members in Greenup County.

Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (KTAP)

Your county received \$411,999 in KTAP issuance. This has been allocated to 141 households in the past fiscal year.

On average, SNAP supported 4,121 people a month in Greenup County, stretching over 1,865 households. Total SNAP spending in your county in fiscal year 2023: \$7,440,540

Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

Greenup County received \$527,100 in funding. Donations and volunteer time totaled \$206,432. Additional grants totaled \$152,000. Throughout the Commonwealth 84% of all enrolled students received at least one FRYSC service. Over 26,000 caregivers participated in Grandparent/Relative Support Groups, and over 36,000 students participated in FRYSC-sponsored mentoring programs.

Greenup County received \$39,375 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance, supporting up to 104 providers a month.

The Division of Child Support Enforcement served 1,524 children, collecting \$2,397,404 in current and past due child support, during fiscal year 2023. The agency established 1,574 orders.

There were 56 children cared for by foster families, 54 of whom received a combined per-diem totaling \$5,560.

16% of children in foster care had a goal of adoption.
83% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting (KASPER)

According to KASPER data, 9,068 unique patients residing in your county received a pharmaceutical controlled substance. Opioid analgesics accounted for 26,959 of the 65,657 total controlled prescriptions dispensed.

Residents of your county received these prescriptions from 1,875 prescribers and 260 dispenser DEA numbers.
