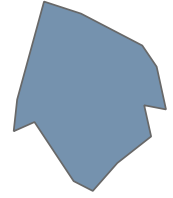

Kentucky

Serve Kentucky manages AmeriCorps programs across the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky. 688 AmeriCorps members served 750,569 hours and recruited 4,705 volunteers who provided 181,290 hours of volunteer service (valued at \$5,429,636). AmeriCorps members served 45,685 students and provided food support services to 2,609 students. Serve Kentucky also provided housing services to 1,730 individuals and collected 75,035 pounds of food for individuals facing food insecurity.

AmeriCorps has 10 members in Jessamine County.

Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (KTAP)

Your county received \$423,455 in KTAP issuance. This has been allocated to 175 households in the past fiscal year.

On average, SNAP supported 5,562 people a month in Jessamine County, stretching over 2,350 households. Total SNAP spending in your county in fiscal year 2023: \$10,918,647

Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

Jessamine County received \$819,840 in funding. Donations and volunteer time totaled \$301,898. Additional grants totaled \$202,750. Throughout the Commonwealth 84% of all enrolled students received at least one FRYSC service. Over 26,000 caregivers participated in Grandparent/Relative Support Groups, and over 36,000 students participated in FRYSC-sponsored mentoring programs.

Jessamine County received \$210,556 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance, supporting up to 357 providers a month.

The Division of Child Support Enforcement served 2,241 children, collecting \$3,373,210 in current and past due child support, during fiscal year 2023. The agency established 2,285 orders.

There were 64 children cared for by foster families, 50 of whom received a combined per-diem totaling \$4,581.

44% of children in foster care had a goal of adoption.

76% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

13 child(ren) adopted

Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting (KASPER)

According to KASPER data, 14,820 unique patients residing in your county received a pharmaceutical controlled substance. Opioid analgesics accounted for 41,453 of the 105,844 total controlled prescriptions dispensed.

Residents of your county received these prescriptions from 3,133 prescribers and 469 dispenser DEA numbers.
