### Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

FRYSC in Lyon County received \$97,737 in funding, grants, community cash, and in-kind contributions with 1 full-time staff and 0 part-time staff.

As of 7/3/2022, there were 24 children in Out of Home Care, 22 of which received a per-diem, for a daily per-diem of \$2,516.

41% of children in the state's care had a goal of adoption. 58% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

2 child(ren) adopted (YTD)

Lyon County received \$20,421 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance supporting up to 13 providers a month. The Division of Child Support Enforcement served on average 253 children a month, collecting \$579,347 in current and past due child support during FY 2022. They established 21 orders.
