Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

Magoffin County received \$346,290 in funding. Donations and volunteer time totaled \$75,735. Additional grants totaled \$58,480. Throughout the Commonwealth 84% of all enrolled students received at least one FRYSC service. Over 26,000 caregivers participated in Grandparent/Relative Support Groups, and over 36,000 students participated in FRYSC-sponsored mentoring programs.

Magoffin County received \$292 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance, supporting up to 2 providers a month. The Division of Child Support Enforcement served 699 children, collecting \$956,764 in current and past due child support, during fiscal year 2023. The agency established 750 orders.

There were 19 children cared for by foster families, 16 of whom received a combined per-diem totaling \$2,195.

25% of children in foster care had a goal of adoption. 47% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).
