Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

FRYSC in Rowan County received \$408,308 in funding, grants, community cash, and in-kind contributions with 6 full-time staff and 1 part-time staff.

As of 7/3/2022, there were 57 children in Out of Home Care, 53 of which received a per-diem, for a daily per-diem of \$2,766.

22% of children in the state's care had a goal of adoption. 77% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).

3 child(ren) adopted (YTD)

Rowan County received \$551,154 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance supporting up to 187 providers a month. The Division of Child Support Enforcement served on average 1,124 children a month, collecting \$1,658,798 in current and past due child support during FY 2022. They established 48 orders.
