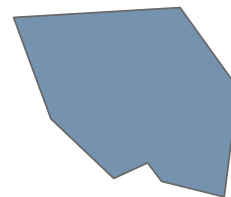

Across the entire state of Kentucky 6,350 Serve KY volunteers provided 29,524 hours of volunteer service (valued at \$803,052) in a little over a year between August 2019 and August 2020.

AmeriCorps members served 28,047 students and provided food support services to 56,877 students. Serve KY also provided housing services to 3,539 individuals.

AmeriCorps has 1 members in Edmonson County.

Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (KTAP)

Your county has received \$106,754 in KTAP issuance. This has been allocated to 48 households in the past fiscal year.

Division of Family Resource and Youth Services Centers (FRYSC)

Edmonson County received \$187,537 in funding and contracts with 7 full-time staff and 0 part-time staff.

As of 7/4/2021, there were 25 children cared for by foster families, 19 of which received a combined per-diem of \$1,152.
24% of children in foster care had a goal of adoption.
76% had a goal other than adoption (e.g. reunification).
0 child(ren) adopted

Edmonson County received \$107,048 from the Child Care Assistance Program issuance supporting up to 35 providers a month.

The Division of Child Support Enforcement served 554 children collecting \$760,633 in current and past due child support during FY 2021. They established 25 orders.
