






Top Prescribed Controlled Substances by Therapeutic Category by Doses – Q2 2017



Opioid Morphine Equivalent Dose (MED) Data Q2 2017





Patients with Seven or More Days of Overlapping Opioid and Benzodiazepine Prescriptions Q2 2017





Controlled Substance Prescribing Q2 2017







Hydrocodone Prescribing Q2 2017







Oxycodone Prescribing Q2 2017













Tramadol Prescribing Q2 2017







Buprenorphine/Naloxone Prescribing Q2 2017







Oxymorphone Prescribing Q2 2017




