

Kentucky Prescription Drug Monitoring Program Announcement

Kentucky All Schedule Prescription Electronic Reporting (KASPER), Kentucky's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program, is pleased to announce the implementation of a new Pharmacist Dashboard designed specifically for Pharmacists-in-Charge (PICs). This enhancement allows eligible PICs to monitor controlled substance reporting activity, review uncorrected file validation errors, and track compliance-related information for their pharmacy submissions. Eligible Pharmacists-in-Charge may access the dashboard within the KASPER portal by selecting "My Account Settings" and then choosing the "Pharmacy Dashboard" menu option.

The dashboard is intended to help PICs identify reporting concerns early, support timely corrections within the required compliance window, and improve the overall quality and accuracy of data submitted to KASPER.
